Training Objectives:

- Teach you how to recognize and report child abuse and neglect
- Help you in understanding child protection law
- The responsibilities of mandated reporters
- Indicators of child abuse and neglect
- How to respond to a disclosure of abuse
- Understand the role of children's protective services (CPS).

 - Physicians, dentists, physician's assistants, registered dental hygienists, medical examiners, nurses, person's licensed to provide emergency medical care, audiologists, psychologists, marriage and family therapists, licensed professional counselors, social workers, licensed master's social workers, licensed bachelor's social workers, registered social service technicians, social service technicians, school administrators, school counselors or teachers, law enforcement officers, members of the clergy, or regulated child care providers.
